The following item will be heard during the regular meeting of the Melbourne City Council. The meeting will begin at 6:30 p.m. See full City Council agenda for location of the following item.

1. A Joint Resolution for the Contract for Sale and Purchase of 805 Palmetto Avenue by the City of Melbourne and the Melbourne Downtown Community Redevelopment Agency in the amount of \$500,000 including a budget amendment to establish a project and budget appropriations in the amount of \$530,000.
 - a. Approval of Joint Resolution No. 4170 for the Contract For Sale and Purchase and authorization for the City Manager to execute the agreement and related documents.
 - b. Approval of a budget adjustment to establish Capital Improvement Project No. 13523 - 805 Palmetto Acquisition and Demo, with a transfer of appropriation from Capital Project No. 14011 - South Expansion Streetscape Project.

Mayor Paul Alfrey, Vice Mayor Mark LaRusso and Council Member Tim Thomas, as members of the Airport Authority Board, may discuss Airport Authority issues, which may subsequently be addressed by the Airport Authority.

Council Members Yvonne Minus, Mimi Hanley, Julie Sanders and Vice Mayor Mark LaRusso (alternate), as members of the Space Coast Transportation Planning Organization (SCTPO), may discuss SCTPO issues, which may subsequently be addressed by the SCTPO.
